Supplementary Regulations

- JURISDICTION** Held under the National Sporting Code of the ACU and the Enduro Standing Regulations of the ACU, the rules of the South Eastern Centre ACU, these Supplementary Regulations and any further instructions that may be issued. Insured under the ACU Basic policy which **DOES NOT** insure competitors for personal accident.
- ELIGIBILITY** Open to members of clubs affiliated to the ACU riding solo motorcycles.
To qualify for South Eastern Championship points, competitors must be a member of and entered under, a club affiliated to the South Eastern Centre. Only South Eastern Enduro Combine clubs qualify for Club Championship points.

Competitors must be in possession of an ACU competition licence, or obtain a one-day licence, priced at £10, from the organisers.
- ENTRIES** To be sent to the Secretary of the Meeting with the entry fee. Acknowledgement of Entry (via Riders' List) will be found on our Club website and the Combine website. Final instructions and Results will be mailed to you.

Entries open 4 April and close 8 May 2010 **or when full – limit 180 riders**
ENTRY FEE Solo £40.
- COURSE** Approximately 10 miles of woodland without roadwork
- CLASSES** Championship, Expert, Veteran (Over40 Clubman), Clubman, Sportsman.
(All but Sportsman are title classes)
- AWARDS** As South Eastern rules, extended to Sportsman, subject to six entries in each class.
- TYRES** REAR must be an **FIM approved enduro tyre** or trials tyre. Max tread depth 13mm. So-called road legal motocross tyres are not acceptable. Front optional.
- MEDICATION** You may be asked to take part in a drugs test. *It is your responsibility to declare at signing on if taking any drugs.*
- GENERAL** **The course will cross public rights of way. Failure to comply with instructions at such points renders your public liability insurance invalid, and will incur immediate exclusion !!!!! A sound meter and datatag operator may be present at the event. BE WARNED.**

Entry declaration: I / we the undersigned apply to enter the event described above and in consideration thereof:-

- I / we hereby declare that I / we have had the opportunity to read, and that I / we understand the National Sporting Code of the ACU, the ACU Standing Regulations, such Supplementary Regulations as have or may be issued for the event, and agree to be bound by them.
- I / we further declare that I am / we are physically and mentally fit to take part in the event and I am / we are competent to do so.
- I / we confirm that I / we understand the nature and type of event we are entering and its inherent risks and agree to accept the same notwithstanding that such risks may involve negligence on the part of the organisers or officials.
- I / we confirm that the machine(s) as described below which I / we compete on shall be suitable and proper for the purpose.
- I/we confirm that I/we are eligible to compete on the machines for which I/we have entered.
- I / we confirm that if any part of the event takes place on a public highway, the machine(s) described below shall be insured as required by the Road Traffic Acts, or equivalent legislation, and that it / they will comply with the regulations in respect thereof.

- I/we confirm that I/we are not suspended or my/our ACU Licence has not been suspended/withdrawn from any ACU competition.
- **I/we understand and accept that as the Supplementary Regulations state the Insurance cover for this event is "Basic" there is no Personal Accident cover for Competitors and Liability cover in respect of any claim made by third parties is limited to £10 million and £5 million for Medical Mal-practice.**
